Amidst the quietness of certain Roman alleys, near the Botanical Garden and a short stroll from the Gianicolo promenade, we propose a dwelling for lovers of the Old City.

Spread over a single level, on the top floor of an early 20th-century building.

Completely restored and finished, the interior surface is divided into: entrance with living space, two rooms, furnished and equipped kitchen, hallway, bathroom, built-in wardrobes, and storage rooms. Additionally equipped with independent heating, air conditioning system, and double glazed anti-break windows.

There is also the possibility of renting a covered parking space in a garage on the street.

The Trastevere District.
